

## Traffic Management and Parking Schedule

### Battle of Flowers 2018

#### Arrangements for Event Arena

Public roads and places to be closed	Period of closure
Lay-bys containing parking places on the promenade on the seaward side of Victoria Avenue (numbered in order proceeding westward from West Park) –	
(a) the first lay-by	Between 6 p.m. on Sunday 5th August 2018 and midnight on Sunday 12th August 2018
(b) the second lay-by	Between 6 p.m. on Sunday 5th August 2018 and midnight on Monday 13th August 2018
(c) the third lay-by	Between 6 p.m. on Friday 3rd August 2018 and 8 p.m. on Monday 13th August 2018
(d) the fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh lay-bys	Between 6 p.m. on Wednesday 8th August 2018 and 6 a.m. on Saturday 11th August 2018
The promenade, the cycle path and the gardens on the seaward side of Victoria Avenue between West Park and Bel Royal	Between 12 noon and 5 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018, and again between 7.15 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018.
(a) Victoria Avenue between The Esplanade and Bel Royal (b) the Lower Park (c) Tyneville Lane (d) Paris Lane (e) the spur road leading from Victoria Avenue into St. Aubin's Road at First Tower (f) Farley's Lane (g) La Rue du Galet	Between 9.30 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018, and again between 6.15 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018
(a) Victoria Avenue between The Esplanade and the junction with the spur road leading from Victoria Avenue into St. Aubin's Road at First Tower (b) the Lower Park (c) Tyneville Lane (d) Paris Lane (e) the spur road leading from Victoria Avenue into St. Aubin's Road at First Tower	Between midnight on Friday 10th August 2018 and 3 a.m. on Saturday 11th August 2018

#### Other Road Closures

- Between 9.15 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018, and between 6 p.m. on Friday 10th August 2018 and 3 a.m. on Saturday 11th August 2018 the following roads will be closed:-
  - La Rue de Haut to traffic proceeding west from its junction with Le Mont Cambrai; and
  - The spur road that leads from La Route de St. Aubin to the Esplanade to eastbound traffic.
- Between 9.15 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018, and between 6 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018, the following roads will be closed:-
  - La Rue de la Ville Emphrie to eastbound traffic; and
  - St. Peter's Valley, between Bel Royal and the junction with La Rue de Haut, to southbound traffic other than buses and large goods vehicles; and

### **Other Road Traffic Changes**

Between 9.30 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018 and between 6.15 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018, vehicles will be permitted to drive: –

- Into La Route de St. Aubin from La Route de la Haule; and
- Into La Route de la Haule from La Route de St. Aubin.

### **Changes to Road Side Parking**

- Between 7 a.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018 and 3 a.m. on Saturday 11th August 2018 vehicles will not be permitted to park, remain parked, or wait on either side of La Route de St. Aubin between West Park and Bel Royal.
- Between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018 and between 4 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018 vehicle will not be permitted to park, remain parked, or wait on either side of Gloucester Street between The Parade and The Esplanade.
- Between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Thursday 9th August 2018 and between 4 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018 vehicles will not be permitted to park, remain parked, or wait on either side Le Mont Cochon.

### **Closure of beach**

Between 6.15 p.m. and midnight on Friday 10th August 2018 the beach in St. Aubin's Bay between the western wall of Elizabeth Marina and an imaginary line running from north to south and intersecting the sea wall at a point corresponding to the western boundary of the Old Station Café will be closed to vehicles and members of the public.

While the beach is closed, the license holder may nevertheless use the beach for the purpose of the event and at its discretion admit any vehicle (e.g. an emergency vehicle) or member of the public to any part of the display area for any particular purpose that does not involve opening the display area to the public in general.
